





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












HORIZONTAL BY SCREW AADJUSTMENT




LATERAL BY SCREW B ADJUSTMENT




VERTICAL BY SCREW C ADJUSTMENT





ANTI-TIPPING INSTALLMENT INSTRUCTIONS FURNITURE TIPPING RESTRAINT

WARNING

Injury may result from tipping furniture.

This restraint may protect against tipping furniture.

Do not allow children to climb on furniture.


This restraint is not a substitute for proper adult supervision.

Failure to detach this restraint before moving the furniture may result in injury and damage.

This restraint must be screwed to a wood stud on the wall, using the long screw provided.


STEP 1

Secure the bracket to the back top of the unit, using the short screw provided, as shown in the drawing.



STEP 2

Locate the wood stud on the wall, and secure the other bracket, 2 inches below the back of the unit.



STEP 3

Place the furniture into position so both mounting brackets are vertically in line. Lace the end of the restraint strap through the larger hole in each mounting bracket. Bring both ends together and slide the flat end through the locking end, and drag it through, until the slack is removed. Ensure that the strap is securely laced and locked.
